**Absentee & Early Voting**

Absentee voting on paper ballots through the mail is available for this election and can be obtained by contacting the office of the City Clerk. Absentee voting applications can be mailed beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 30, 2018, and Early Voting in person on electronic voting machines begins at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 14, 2018. Absentee voting and Early Voting on voting machines ends at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2018.

Absentee and Early Voting will be conducted in the Office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 505 Sims St, during regular business hours, which are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. ***THERE WILL BE VOTING DURING THE NOON HOUR.***
