

Requirements for a "Library Card"

Approved by the Truth or Consequences Public Library Advisory Board June 26, 2007

Truth or Consequences Public Library does not, at this time, issue physical cards for patrons to carry. For the purposes of this document, "Library Card" refers to the electronic patron record maintained in the Library's database.

Any individual who can sign his/her full name and has no previous derogatory borrowing record, and who can verify his/her mailing address may apply for a library card.

A new patron may check out up to three items as soon as the application is approved.

No patron may check out items from the Library on any card other than his/her own.

REQUIRED FOR ADULTS:

1. Photo ID
AND
2. Mail with a current postmark
OR
3. City utility bill showing current date
OR
4. A valid library card from a New Mexico Library.

REQUIRED FOR PERSONS UNDER 18:

A parent or guardian willing to accept responsibility for all borrowed items.
